DEADLINES/IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- **Tuition deposit** of \$145.00 is due no later than July 10, 2009 (you are welcome to pay the full amount if that is convenient for you)
- **Financial aid requests** (50% of the tuition fee is the maximum award) are due no later than July 10, 2009
- The **tuition balance** is due no later than September 15, 2009
- **Sibling discounts:** Families with two student participants may deduct 10% from the total tuition costs; families with three or more students may deduct 15% from the total tuition costs.
- *Any students whose tuition has not been paid by the stated deadlines may be dropped from the program.*

FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION PROCESS:

A limited amount of financial aid (up to 50% of the tuition) will be awarded on the basis of need and funds available. In order to help the Financial Aid Committee evaluate each application fairly, please write a letter to serve as a need-analysis document. Factors such as family size, extraordinary expenses, and gross income are pertinent and should be included. Please give the committee a general sense of the basis for your financial aid request. All information given in this application is confidential, privileged information for use only by a small review committee appointed by the Board of Directors. **All requests must be in writing.**

In order for a financial aid application to be considered, it must be received in the AYS Office no later than July 10, 2009 with your tuition deposit of \$145.00, the Parent Survey and the Permission to Participate form. Please send your letter to:
